On September 30, 1882 *Hearthstone* Historic House became the first private home in the world lit by a hydroelectric central station using the Thomas A. Edison electric system. Designed by prominent Midwest architect William Waters, *Hearthstone* Historic House is a stunning showcase of late 19th Century style and ingenuity. Built in 1881 and 1882 for the Appleton Paper and Pulp Mill manager Henry J. Rogers and his family, *Hearthstone* is a "must see" Appleton attraction.

Hearthstone welcomes guests to tour the past and visit an exciting era in American history. View original *electroliers* and light switches in use and learn about the effect electric light had on society.

Stop by the Hydro-Adventure Center! Kids of all ages will enjoy learning about electricity while trying these fun hands-on activities. Try using one of Edison's light switches, or try to generate enough electricity to make our model electric trolley work.
